Theme

These two-day workshops will enable participants to explore how on-going life story work contributes to children's and young people's understanding of their past, present and future.

The day will include:

- actively integrating all aspects of a child/young person into his/her life story including race, gender, age, culture, disability and religion.
- understanding the impact of child development and attachment difficulties when undertaking life story work.
- an opportunity to enhance skills in communicating with children and the use of a variety of tools including genograms, stories, CD roms and games.

Children's social workers, fostering & adoption social workers, social work assistants, family resource workers, family centre and residential workers, leaving care workers, foster carers and adopters, CAMHS workers.

This workshop is aimed at workers and carers who are fairly new to life story work and wish to enhance their skills and knowledge.
